

REQUEST FOR TENDER

for

lease for research purposes of bacteria composite – phosphorus mineralisation activator

for the purposes of "**Development and implementation of lake reclamation and surface water protection method based on natural biological technologies employing beneficial microorganisms**" project carried out as part of the publicly co-funded GEKON Programme.

I. EMPLOYER

II. SPECIFICATION OF THE OBJECT OF CONTRACT

1. The object of contract is lease of microbiological composite of specific activity in respect of mineralisation of organic phosphorous fractions, with the right to modify the composite through merging it with other bacteria strains used in water revitalisation and removal of petroleum-derived substances. Such properties of the achieved composition as preservation of functional parameters, preservation of adequate species composition (correspondence), maintaining the required level of activity of the mixed-species complex achieved, as well as stability throughout storage period shall be studied.
2. Lease of microbiological composite of specific activity in respect of mineralisation of organic phosphorous fractions exclusively concerns research carried out in the scope specified in par.1 and does not concern use of the composite for any commercial purposes.
3. Lease of microbiological composite of specific activity in respect of mineralisation of organic phosphorous fractions concerns lease for research purposes for a period of 11 months.
4. Requirements concerning principal qualities of the base composite:
 - a. composition – exclusively probiotic, genetically unmodified strains of microorganisms,
 - b. shelf life period – not shorter than 12 months.
5. Detailed specification of the object of contract:

The object of contract should include:

A/ Composition of the base microbiological composite of specific activity in respect of mineralisation of organic phosphorous fractions,

- B/ Quality inspection method,
- C/ Determination of the effects of use,
- D/ Right to examine, modify, and combine with other strains of microorganisms
- E/ Comprehensive legal services covering temporary transfer of licensing rights for a period of minimum 11 months, i.e. duration of research work

2. Date of execution of the object of contract:

The Employer determines the period of contract execution at 1 February 2016 – 31 December 2016.

III. CONDITIONS FOR ADMISSION TO PROCEEDINGS

1. Contractor who duly submits a price bid for execution of the object of contract is entitled to apply for the contract.
2. Exclusively entitled to apply for the contract are entities which have run operations in the above mentioned scope for a period not shorter than 5 years.

IV. CONDITIONS FOR EXCLUSION FROM PROCEEDINGS

1. Entities associated personally or by capital with the Employer are not entitled to participate in the bidding procedure. Absence of such association should be declared by submitting to the Employer a signed Declaration of personal and/or capital non-association, which constitutes Appendix 2 to the present Request.
2. Tenders assuming use of genetically modified microorganisms in the composition of the base preparation which constitutes the object of contract shall not be considered.

V. TENDER EVALUATION CRITERIA

1. It is obligatory that Tenderers meet all the criteria specified in Art. III and IV of the Request for Tender.
2. From among tenders meeting the above requirements, the economically most effective tender shall be selected according to the criteria specified below:

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1.	Total price	100	price ratio of lowest tender to price of tender under evaluation (x 100)
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3. For the purpose of tender comparison, gross price shall be adopted.
4. The tender should specify net and gross (incl. VAT) prices in Polish zlotys, or in other currency, whose amount for the purposes of tender comparison shall be converted into Polish zlotys at exchange rates announced by the National Bank of Poland (www.nbp.pl – "kurs średni waluty" [average rate of exchange]) on the day of publication of the Request for Tender, i.e. on 8 January 2016.
5. The price should be specified on consideration of all purchase discounts.
6. The lowest price tender shall be selected.
7. The Employer reserves the right to enter into negotiations with the Contractor whose tender has been selected as the economically most effective in terms of price, provided that the negotiations can only be held in order to lower the price quoted by the Contractor.

VI. PLACE, MANNER AND DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION OF TENDERS

1. Tender submitted in a sealed envelope marked "**Lease for research purposes of bacteria composite – phosphorus mineralisation activator**" must be delivered in the following manner:
 - a. registered mail against acknowledgement of receipt, or
 - b. sent by hand, or
 - c. delivered in person to the Employer's office

VII. TENDER PREPARATION METHOD

1. The tender should be made out in Polish or English on the appended tender form, which constitutes Appendix 1 to the present Request. Total net and gross prices, as well as VAT should be indicated in the tender.
2. The tender should be signed by a person authorised to represent the Tenderer's company.

3. The tender should be appended with a signed statement, which constitutes Appendix 2 to the present Request.

VIII. FINAL REMARKS

1. All expenses associated with preparation and submission of the tender incl. appendices are exclusively incurred by the Tenderer.
2. The Employer reserves the right to terminate or abrogate the proceedings for convenience.
3. Subject to the provision of par. 2 above, tender selection process shall be completed not later than on 25 January 2016.
4. The Request for Tender is available on www.probiotics.pl webpage and at the Employer's office.
5. The Employer reserves the right to change the provisions of the Agreement concluded with reference to the contents of the tender subject to which the Contractor has been selected, should new information and facts appear to render execution of the agreement impossible in the original form, and provided it does not affect the goals and results of the project, and the change will be introduced for the benefit of the project. Introduction of changers will be exclusively subject to agreement between both Parties to the Contract.
